



# 20-And's Scholarships

For students planning to attend Porterville College

20-And's Scholarships will be given to qualifying local senior students who will enter Porterville College this fall and carry a minimum of 12 units. The scholarship is intended to assist students who are pursuing a career.

## Requirements:

1. 3.0 or higher G.P.A. in high school
2. Attending Porterville College in the fall semester after high school graduation and enrolling in 12 or more units.

## Amount and Disbursement:

The number of qualifying applicants and available funds will determine the amount awarded to each student. Scholarships will be paid in two equal installments:

1. At the beginning of the fall semester, student will provide proof of enrollment in 12 units or more at Porterville College. One half of the total scholarship will be paid at that time.

2. After the fall semester, student will provide proof of completion of 12 or more units with a minimum 3.0 G.P.A. and proof of enrollment in 12 or more units for the following spring semester. At that time, the second half of the scholarship will be paid.

## Application:

Student must submit all of the following to be considered:

1. High school transcript
2. Two letters of recommendation from high school staff and/or administration on official school letterhead
3. Completed application form
4. A recent 4" X 6" photo

The deadline for complete submissions is April 1, 2016.  
Applications postmarked after that date will not be accepted.
