

## Scholarships

The Porterville Garden Club is pleased to announce competition for \$500 scholarships for students from the following schools: Granite Hills, Monache, Porterville, Citrus, Strathmore and Frazier High Schools.

To be eligible for consideration applicants must be pursuing, or intending to pursue a career in one or more of the following disciplines: Ornamental Horticulture, Botany, Forestry, Landscape Design, Agronomy, Floral Design, Entomology, Urban Planning or other Agriculture related fields.

Those attending a community college or university must be currently enrolled for at least 12 units per session of instruction. For those attending a technical or vocational school, attendance and achievement criteria required by the school will apply.

A payment of \$250 will be made to the successful applicant upon the receipt of proof of registration as a full time student. The \$250 remaining balance of the award will be paid upon receipt of fall semester grades and a record of enrollment as a full-time student for the following semester. Transcript must show both passing grades and evidence that this student is following one of the above required career paths.

Interested students should submit the Application Form school transcript, attendance record, two letters of recommendation, and a personal letter detailing career ambition. Applications are available from your school counselor or your scholarship committee listed below.

The committee will review qualifications and select winners on the basis of commitment, achievement, and potential winners will be honored at the April or May meeting at the Garden Clubs 11:30 am luncheon at the Porterville Elks Lodge. Scholarship winners and their parents are invited to be luncheon guests.
