Requirements of applicant

- Open to graduating high school seniors in Tulare County.
- Minimum of 50 hours of volunteer service, outside of school, which focuses on improving literacy in Tulare County
- Two letters of recommendation
- Must have a minimum 2.5 GPA
- Must plan to attend a college, university or vocational/trade school in the U.S.

Applications Instructions

- Complete all portions of the application. Incomplete applications may be disqualified from consideration.
- Include a paragraph explaining details of project the reason you chose this work or project. Include name of project(s), the organization(s) you worked with, the number of people reached, any involvement that included follow through with associated projects, and possible project spin offs, if applicable.
- Applications may be typed or handwritten
- Applications are due by April 15.

Project will be

- Judged on creativity and originality in addition to overall impact on improving literacy in Tulare County.
- Read and judged by a committee who will then make the decision regarding the recipient of the award.

Award will be:

- \$500 award will be paid directly to the school to be attended by the award recipient.
- Scholarship must be used by Dec. 31 of the year after it is awarded.
