2. Applicant must have at least a cumulative GPA of 3.0 and include an official High School transcript with the application.
3. Provide the following information, demonstrating participation for **each** of your Community Service activity(s); address every item for **each** Community Service activity(s).
 - a. Description of the Community Service activity(s).
 - b. Description of your participation in the Community Service activity(s), including hours of participation.
 - c. Why did you decide to participate in the Community Service activity(s)?
 - d. Is this a onetime project or on-going activity?
 - e. Name and contact information for each project to enable the committee to verify your participation.
